

CB and CBOC are deeply saddened by the passing of Fran McHugh, our condolences are with his family, friends and anyone who had the pleasure of knowing or working with Fran.

A prominent figure in the community, Fran volunteered with many associations. He was an Ambassador for the NB Sports Hall of Fame, a member of the Lancaster Golden Service Club, Co-Founder of the Belfast Children's Vacation Saint John Inc. (a very special project for Carey and Fran), and most recently sat on the Advisory Council of Canada 1st Basketball Inc.

His desire to be further involved in the athletic and sporting community-led Fran to become a basketball and baseball umpire and official. He was a charter member of NBAABO where he served in many administrative positions; officiated in 6 Canadian National Tournaments; and was an international referee travelling to places like Peru, Czechoslovakia, Korea, Mexico, England, Taiwan, and Bulgaria.
